

All Net Control Stations should keep this summary for reference.

Speak clearly and slowly.

A - NCS Procedure in this order:

1. Call the Net using the correct preamble, 2m or 75m, and on-time.
2. Ask for **formal traffic** to be listed
3. Ask for **club announcements** to be listed
4. Ask for **training** to be listed.
5. Ask for **check in's** A - M, N - Z, A - Z

B - After taking check in's:

- 6.. Move any **formal traffic** if there were any listed in this order. Emergency, Priority, Welfare, Routine.
7. Call for **club announcements** if there were any listed.
8. Call for any late check in's, A - Z.
9. Call for **training** if there was any listed. (One session per Net)
 - a. Don't do any training until you have stations checked in.
 - b. Q & A session on training if needed.

C - End of Business Session:

10. Stations checking out (I/O) after the Business Session can leave the Net now.

D - General Comments Session

11. NCS calls remaining stations for their comments.

E - NCS Closes the Net using the text at bottom of the preamble.

The 2-meter Net is called at 9:00pm each Wednesday night on the W4SNC repeater. A 77 Hz tone is required at all times to access this repeater. 146.085 input, 146.685 output.

The 75-meter Net is called at 8:30pm each Saturday night on **3972** kHz LSB +/- kHz increments to avoid interference. Those frequencies are: 3966, 3969, **(3972)**, 3978, 3981.
