## Events in Radio

1910

[Wireless Ship Act of 1910](#) passed by the [United States Congress](#), requiring all ships of the United States traveling over two-hundred miles off the coast and carrying over fifty passengers to be equipped with wireless radio equipment with a range of one hundred miles. Replaced by the 1912 Radio Act, which was enacted primarily because of the sinking of the Titanic.

**8 October:** The first broadcast of American football is on the air via KDKA as the [University of Pittsburgh](#) defeats [West Virginia University](#) at Pittsburgh's Forbes Field.
